WHAT IS REPORTABLE TO TITLE IX?

Any sex- and gender-based discrimination and harassment
Sex- and gender-based includes gender identity and sexual orientation

Sexual Violence

Sexual assault, stalking, domestic violence

Sexual Harassment

Quid pro quo / hostile environment

Prohibited Conduct / Non-Compliance

Invasion of sexual privacy, Indecent exposure, Sexual intercourse with a minor, Retaliation, Sexual exploitation, Violation of a Title IX No-Contact-Directive, Failure of responsible employee to make a Title IX report

Sex- or Gender-Based Discrimination

Unequal pay or treatment, Unfair hiring, pregnancy/lactation related discrimination

Forms of discrimination and violence that are not related to sex or gender identity and/or that do not have a romantic nature are not under the scope of Title IX but can be reported to Student Conduct, Academic Personnel, Staff HR, or police.
